## Program Descriptions

### March 3, 2010 - Integrating Dental Implants Into Your Everyday Practice with Bill Kukucka

This program will provide an overview of the appropriate indications and prosthetic applications for dental implant patients. A wide variety of restorative options will be presented from the fully edentulous patient to those missing single or multiple teeth.

### March 31, 2010 - The Surgical Management of Dental Implants with Dr. Ziad Tohme

This program will discuss advanced technology in bone grafting and provide an overview of the benefits of dental implants from a patient and a clinical practice perspective.

Doctor Track: **Implants: Restorative Decision Making and**

#### **Treatment Planning with Dr. Dean Morton**

## Speakers and Registration

**Dr. Dean Morton** is a Professor in the Department of Diagnostic Sciences, Prosthodontics and Restorative Dentistry at the University of Louisville School of Dentistry, and Assistant Dean for Multidisciplinary Implant and Esthetic Dentistry. Dr. Morton is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and a Fellow or member of the American College of Prosthodontists, International College of Dentists, and the International Team for Implantology (ITI). He is also a consultant for the ADA Commission on Dental Accreditation, and is a reviewer for several scientific publications including the Journal of Periodontology and the Journal of Prosthodontics. Dr. Morton has authored or co-authored more than 40 scientific articles and lectures extensively on implants and esthetic dentistry. He maintains a practice limited to Implant and Esthetic Dentistry and Prosthodontics at the University of Louisville School of Dentistry.

**Corrine Woodworth** is a practicing RDH in specialty office, and an auxiliary member of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. She graduated from Lakeland Community College in 1984. Corrine served as president of the Ohio Dental Hygienists' Association for two terms and in other various capacities on a national level.
